This is the hashtag we will use alongside **Birmingham Learners Together**:

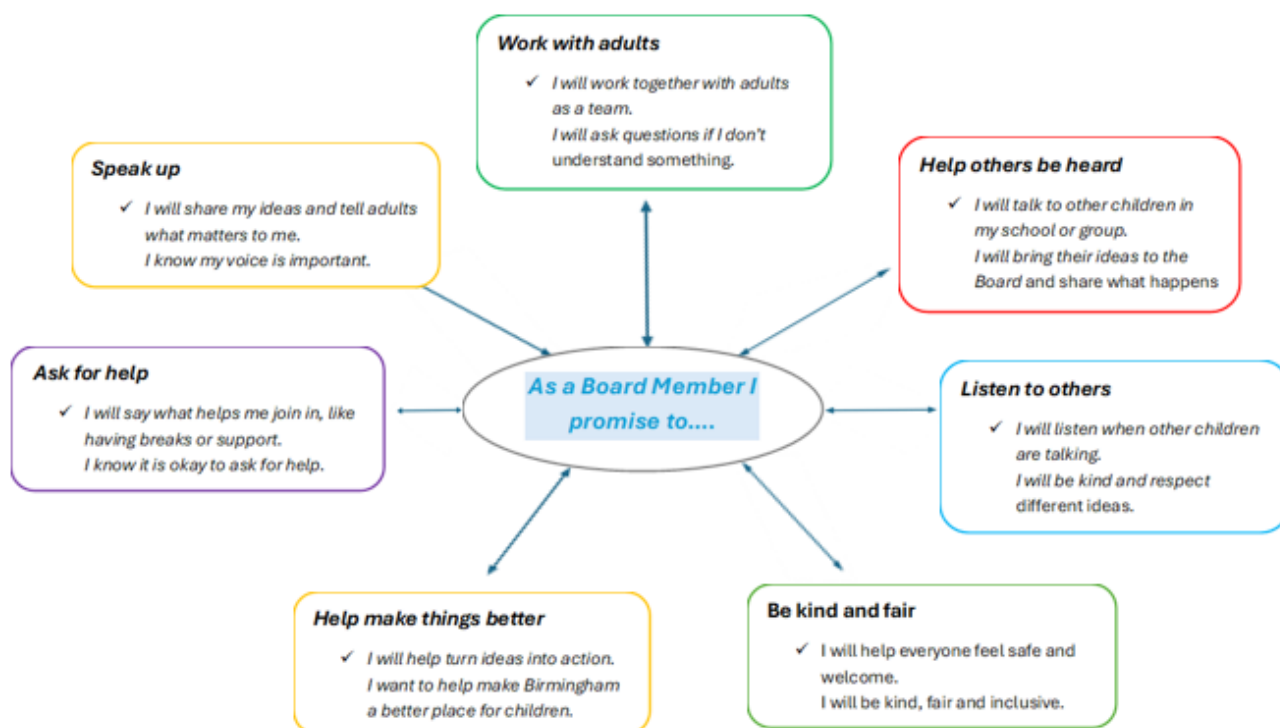
- **Our Voices** – learners share ideas in different ways (talking, drawing, signing, symbols, writing).
